

## NYSIM Celebrates 2nd Birthday! (September 6, 2013)

On September 6, 2013, NYSIM celebrated its 2nd birthday. By September 2013, NYSIM hosted a total of over 24,000



Learner Visits. This was over and beyond NYSIM's initial estimates of 10,000 Learner Visits annually despite the interruption from Super Storm Sandy in November, December, & January. NYSIM hosted 12,000 visits during its second year.

Usage of NYSIM increased for both NYU Langone Medical Center and CUNY but the major increase came from the addition of many new CUNY schools including New York City College of Technology, Bronx Community College, LaGuardia Community College, NY Community College and Kingsborough Community College. In total, counting Borough of Manhattan Community College and Hunter, the CUNY school

usage was up 155% in year two. Programs sponsored by NYSIM also increased by 85% over the first year.
