# Maintenance of Certification in Anesthesiology (MOCA) at NYSIM

In collaboration with Drs. Brian Kaufman and Mitchell Lee, NYSIM hosted our first Maintenance of Certification in Anesthesiology (MOCA) course on December 4, 2016. In 2016 NYSIM received a formal endorsement by the American Society of Anesthesiologists to host a MOCA Simulation Course which satisfies the requirement of MOCA 2.0 Part 4: Improvement in Medical Practice. There are 2 additional centers in the New York metropolitan area that are endorsed to host this course. The simulation realistically replicates clinical scenarios that participants can work through in a manner similar to what they may experience in clinical practice. The team hopes to conduct 4 more courses in the 2017 calendar year.
