NYSIM Highlights: New Task Trainers!

NYSIM is pleased to share two new task trainers acquired to improve and expand simulation education resources. The first, pictured to the right, is an **Abdominal Examination Task Trainer** with anatomically accurate adult torso. It includes:

- Normal and abnormal organs, including kidneys, liver, spleen, bladder, aortas, abdominal masses
- Abdominal palpation, percussion, and auscultation
- Allows for various bowel sounds, obstruction, aortic pulses, distension, fluid buildup
- Bench top and hybrid use with Simulated Patient
- Not ultrasoundable

The second, pictured to the left, is a comprehensive **Knot Tying Trainer** with 2 peri-operative openings to practice various surgical knot tying techniques. This task trainer allows for:

- One-handed reef knot technique
- Instrument ties
- Surgeon's knots
- Slip knots
