NYSIM pays tribute to an astonishing career at BMCC/CUNY— President Antonio Perez

Dr. Antonio Perez, a Steering Committee member of NYSIM since its foundation, and 23 year president of Borough of Manhattan Community College announced his retirement from these positions. Dr. Perez's role in the creation of NYSIM cannot be overestimated. As a result of his efforts, New York City and New York State, in the wake of the World Trade disaster, provided funding for building a simulation facility that would provide training for first responders. In 2008 when the opportunity for CUNY to partner with NYU School of Medicine to develop a Simulation Center, Dr. Perez provided leadership in forging the alliance between the two universities, and working with teams to design, build, equip and staff NYSIM. Over the past seven years Dr. Perez served as one of four Steering Committee members, overseeing the operation of NYSIM on behalf of the health science schools of CUNY and NYU. His enthusiastic support for NYSIM and all of the individuals who work and teach here will be greatly missed.

Dr. Perez will assume a new role at CUNY as Professor at Hunter College. We wish him well in this next phase of his career and thank him for his enormous contribution to the success of NYSIM.
